For Australian not-for-profit organisations, community groups or charities

Below is a list of questions you will be required to answer to submit your dream. We recommend preparing and drafting your submission in a word document before submitting online.

10. Tell us about your plans for getting the word out about your dream and attracting votes
11. Enter the links to the website and social media accounts for your chosen not-for-profit organisation or community group

Application requirements for not-for-profit organisations

To qualify, your dream must aim to make a positive difference in the community, and it must also:

- Benefit a registered community cause, charity group or not-for-profit organisation (and not an individual)
- Be based in Australia with funds being spent in Australia
- Be able to be undertaken in the next 12 months
- Fit within the [theme of each category](#) [Better Living, Brighter Futures, Active Community]
- Grants will not be awarded to schools*, medical research, organisations with an annual revenue more than \$5 million, fundraising activities, charity work outside of Australia.

*However, projects run by external not-for-profits that choose to partner with schools will be considered.

Sunsuper Dreams for a Better World is open to all residents of Australia, aged 18 years or older at the time of entry. You don't need to be a Sunsuper member to enter.

After you have submitted and confirmed your dream, if your application meets the requirements we'll send you an email to let you know your entry was approved and will be considered by the judges for a grant. When entries close, if your dream is shortlisted we will contact you via the contact number or email address you used to apply.
